TRANSPORTATION

- Shared ride programs for seniors (minimum of 65 years of age), people with disabilities and any Bucks County resident who is not covered by Medical Assistance
 - Medical Assistance Transport Program (*Must carry a valid ACCESS card*)
 - Can reimburse Medical Assistance eligible riders, or social service providers transporting clients, using public transportation or privately owned vehicles for any medically related trip (e.g. pharmacy, doctors office)
 - Service is provided 8 AM – 5 PM, Monday – Friday, Saturday by special arrangement.
 - Transportation between service areas and to adjacent PA counties ins limited to certain times each day
